### Rider Expectations

2024-2025

- ❖ Obey the instructions of the driver. At no time will a student act toward or address comments to the driver in a disrespectful manner, or refuse to cooperate with the driver.
- ❖ Board and leave the vehicle at your designated stop only.
- ❖ RAILROAD CROSSINGS – Students are to be quiet upon approaching the tracks and remain quiet until the vehicle has cleared tracks.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the parents to provide transportation to school if a child misses the van.
- ❖ Dirt roads are not always safe for a vehicle to travel when wet; therefore it is the parent's responsibility to meet the vehicle at the nearest pavement during these times. If you are not sure if the van will run, call transportation at 770-376-0571

## PROCEDURES FOR WAITING FOR THE VEHICLE

- ❖ Be ready five minutes before scheduled pickup time. The driver will not wait.
- ❖ Stand on the sidewalk or back from the roadway while waiting for the van. No running or horseplay at the vehicle.'
- ❖ Stand clear of the vehicle until it comes to a complete stop
- ❖ When the vehicle approaches, form a line and be prepared to load immediately.
- ❖ Vehicle riders will abide by the individual school's rules and regulations, including conduct and dress code.

## LOADING THE VEHICLE

- ❖ Do not push or shove.
- ❖ Use the handrail and steps.
- ❖ The van will not move until all students are seated.
- ❖ ALL BAGGAGE/BAND INSTRUMENTS – Any items brought on the vehicle must be able to sit in the students lap. Students must be able to hold baggage at all times. NO band instruments larger than a trombone will be allowed in the vehicle.

## CONDUCT ON THE VEHICLE

- ❖ Remain seated at all times while the vehicle. is moving. Each student will be expected to remain seated for the duration of the trip, and remain seated until released by the driver.
- ❖ Do not change seats.
